Time-and-space effect in workshops

COMPLEX, URGENT ISSUES. Divergent understandings of problems, causes and solutions, or many ideas for possible improvements. There are times when it is crucial to find the right way forward in a short time — and be able to anchor the direction.

USING WORKSHOPS AS A METHOD is about bringing people with the right expertise together and getting them to focus on one thing for a limited time. During the workshop we quickly create understanding for each others' viewpoints, balance *urgency* against *importance*, and then produce the combined best solution. This is what we call the time-and-space effect. A group feeling and shared motivation that will continue in the day-to-day operation.
